HHdbVI user licence

HHdbVI refers to the contents of the endgame study database that was created by Harold van der Heijden, and issued in December 2020. Any minor or major changes (e.g. renaming, converting to another format, making subdatabases, modifications, adding material, or any other modification) are irrelevant for the licence – i.e. it then still is HHdbVI, and the conditions for use mentioned here still apply.

A licence to use HHdbVI is strictly personal and cannot be transferred. It allows you to use HHdbVI on as many devices (or other means, including storage in the cloud) you want, as long as you are the only person who has access to the database (direct access of contents, but also any other file operations, like copying *et cetera*).

A licence for HHdbVI is not a licence for future versions (e.g. HHdbVII), you should obtain a new licence then.

The licence does not allow you as the owner of the licence to provide (give, sell, publish, distribute, put on a website, include, or by any other means) the database to others (persons, companies, problem databases, or others). However, it is allowed, and even recommended, to use the contents of the database when writing articles, books, et cetera. In such cases it is recommended to contact Harold van der Heijden, who is very likely to be willing to provide the latest information from HHdbVII (work in progress).

It is not a problem when you forward small subsets (subfiles) of the database (in any format) to others. But when the total you provide (give, sell, publish, distribute, put on a website, include, or otherwise) to others (e.g. persons, companies, problem databases) exceeds 500 studies, you must have an e-mail consent by Harold van der Heijden beforehand.
